This bill creates a presumptive mandatory minimum sentence of three years for certain repeat sex offenders. A person who is convicted of criminal sexual conduct 1-5 within 15 years of a prior sex offense conviction will receive the 3-year sentence unless a longer mandatory minimum sentence applies. A court may stay execution of the sentence only if it finds the offender amenable to inpatient sex offender treatment and imposes local jail time and a requirement of completing inpatient treatment as conditions of the offender's probation.
