Overview

College Possible is a nonprofit organization that provides intense instructional, mentoring and coaching services to low income students for admission, tracking and support of the student while applying to and attending college.

This bill appropriates \$2 million per year from the general fund to the Office of Higher Education for transfer to the College Possible program to expand its services to Minnesota College Possible programs. Requires College Possible to expand opportunities for students in Greater Minnesota.

Requires College Possible to annually report to the legislature information about the expansion of College Possible in Minnesota, including the number of coaches hired, the expansion within existing partner high schools, the expansion of high school partnerships, the number of high school and college students served, the total hours of community service by high school and college students, and a list of communities and organizations benefitting from student service hours.
