Overview

This bill appropriates \$1.625 million for a grant to the Girls in Action program. Specifies that the grant is to expand programs offered by Girls in Action to encourage and support low-income girls, including girls of color, to graduate from high school in a timely manner, complete postsecondary preparation programs, become community leaders, and participate in service learning opportunities. Designates \$500,000 for programs in the Twin Cities metropolitan area.

Section

1 Appropriation. Appropriates \$1,625,000 in fiscal year 2017 from the general fund to the commissioner of education for a grant to the Girls in Action program. Makes the appropriation available until expended.
