Overview

In 2011, a process was initiated to transfer legal responsibility to provide human services to tribal members and their families who reside on or off the reservation in Mahnomen County from the county to the White Earth Band of Ojibwe. This appropriation provides funds for costs associated with the band's child welfare programs.
