This bill gives priority to certain students in the lottery a school district must use when it receives more applications than it has available seats for open enrollment. Students currently enrolled in the highest grade offered by a nonpublic school that is within the boundaries of the school district receive priority if that nonpublic school has an articulation agreement with the school district. An articulation agreement may authorize priority enrollment for students attending the nonpublic school.
