Subject Temporary licensure for guest body artists

Overview

This bill modifies requirements for individuals to apply to the commissioner of health for a temporary license to work as a guest artist. The commissioner of health licenses tattoo technicians, body piercing technicians, and body art technicians, and also issues temporary licenses to guest artists. A guest artist is limited to conducting body art procedures for 30 days or less per calendar year.

Section Description

1 General.

Amends § 146B.04, subd. 1. Provides that the commissioner of health must receive an individual's application for a temporary license to work as a guest artist at least 14 calendar days before the applicant conducts a body art procedure (a body art procedure means physical body adorning, including tattooing and body piercing).
