Subject Data and reporting; ST elevation myocardial infarction response

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Overview

This bill eliminates certain duties of the commissioner of health to report data on ST elevation myocardial infarctions and progress toward improving quality of care and outcomes for patients who experience them. An ST elevation myocardial infarction is a type of heart attack in which the artery carrying blood from the heart to the rest of the body is completely blocked, and parts of the heart supplied by this artery begin to die.

Amends § 144.497. Amends duties of the commissioner of health related to ST elevation myocardial infarction response and treatment in the state, to delete requirements that the commissioner (1) post quarterly summary reports on ST elevation myocardial infarction response and treatment data and (2) annually report to certain legislative committees on progress toward improving quality of care and patient outcomes for ST elevation myocardial infarctions.

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
