Subject Lottery in Lieu Tax

Summary

This bill would increase the amount of revenue from the in lieu of sales tax on state lottery tickets ("lottery in lieu" or LIL) that is dedicated for certain purposes. Under current law, 72.43 percent of the LIL tax is dedicated to five different purposes as follows:

- 1) 50 percent to the heritage enhancement account, which is dedicated to improve, enhance, and protect fish and wildlife resources;
- 2) 22.5 percent for state parks and trails;
- 3) 22.5 percent for metropolitan parks and trails;
- 4) three percent for local trail grants; and
- 5) two percent for zoos, which include the Minnesota Zoo, the Como Zoo, and the Duluth Zoo.

This bill would increase the amount dedicated for these purposes to 99 percent beginning July 1, 2023. The remaining one percent would go to the general fund. Under current law, the amount going to the general fund is 27.57 percent.
