## Summary

This bill appropriates a total of \$540,000 in the FY24-FY25 biennium for grants to the Hennepin County Medical Center to support up to six physicians enrolled in an addiction medicine fellowship program.

Previous higher education budgets have included a grant program to support physicians in an addiction medicine fellowship program. The appropriation was \$210,000 per year in FY17 and FY18 with no money appropriated in FY19 and later. *See* 2016 Laws, ch. 189, art. 1, § 2, subd. 4; 2017 Laws, ch. 89,art. 1, § 2, subd. 27.
