Overview

This bill requires sellers and lessors of goods and services to notify customers of credit or charge card surcharges via certain methods based on whether the sale is in-person, via website, or over the phone.

Summary

Section Description

1 Limitation; prohibition.

Applies this section to both sellers and lessors of goods or services. Clarifies that if the sale or lease of goods and services is processed in-person, a customer must be notified of a credit or charge card surcharge both orally at the time of sale and by a sign posted conspicuously.

Requires that if the sale or lease is through a website or mobile device, a customer must be notified of a credit or charge card surcharge by a conspicuously posted notice during the sale, at the point of sale, on the customer order summary, or on the checkout page of the website.

Requires that if the sale or lease is processed over the phone a customer must be notified of a credit or charge card surcharge orally.
