Overview

The K12 omnibus bill carries a base budget for student organizations.

H.F. 1761 increases the annual funding level for student organizations from its base level of \$768,000 to \$1,084,000 per year and proposes annual appropriations for the following career and technical organizations for the listed amounts:

- \$85,000 for the Minnesota Foundation for Student Organizations (MFSO), an organization that supports secondary and postsecondary career and technical student organizations;
- \$68,000 for student organizations serving health occupations (HOSA);
- \$100,000 for student organizations serving trade and industry occupations (Skills USA);
- \$122,000 for student organizations serving business occupations (BPA);
- \$322,000 for student organizations for Agriculture, Food, and Natural Resources (FFA);
- \$185,000 for student organizations serving family and consumer science occupations (FCCLA); and
- \$202,000 for student organizations serving marketing occupations (DECA).
