## 1 Alcoholism, mental health, and chemical dependency services.

- (h) Requires health plans that include coverage for alcoholism, mental health, or chemical dependency provide reimbursement for benefits through the psychiatric collaborative care model and use certain billing codes.
- (i) Requires the commissioner of commerce to update the list of codes under paragraph (h) if there is any change or addition to billing codes for the psychiatric collaborative care model.
- (j) Defines psychiatric collaborative care model as the behavioral health delivery method described under Federal Register, volume 81, page 80230, and includes certain elements.

## 2 Psychiatric collaborative care model.

- (a) Requires medical assistance to cover the psychiatric collaborative care model for clients.
- (b) Defines psychiatric collaborative care model.
- (c) Requires medical assistance to use certain billing codes for the psychiatric collaborative care model.

**Effective date.** This section is effective July 1, 2023, or upon federal approval, whichever is later. The commissioner of human services shall notify the revisor of statutes when federal approval is obtained.
