Subject Civics Education

Overview

This bill requires students to complete one credit of civics in 11th or 12th grade to graduate from high school, and repeals the requirement that students answer 30 of 50 civics test questions.

Summary

Section Description

1 Required academic standards.

Strikes reference to section that is repealed in section 3.

2 Graduation requirements.

Requires 3.5 credits of social studies required for graduation to include one credit in civics in 11th or 12th grade for students beginning 9th grade in the 2024-2025 school year. Strikes encouragement that districts offer a course for credit in government and citizenship to 11th or 12th graders.

3 Repealer.

Repeals section 120B.02, subdivision 3 (requirement that students answer 50 civics test questions to graduate from high school).

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
