## **Overview**

This bill creates an advisory task force to evaluate issues on state, local, and private infrastructure, including coordination, resiliency, and federal funding. It is effective the day after enactment.

## **Summary**

#### **Section Description**

#### 1 Infrastructure Resilience Advisory Task Force.

Establishes the task force, specifies membership and duties, provides for administration, and requires a legislative report.

- **Subd. 1. Definition.** Defines a term.
- **Subd. 2. Establishment.** Creates the task force and specifies its general purpose.
- **Subd. 3. Membership.** Identifies task force membership and appointing authorities, including four legislators, various state commissioners, appointments by the governor, and a number of associations.
- **Subd. 4. Appointments.** Sets an appointment deadline and expertise requirements for some appointees.
- **Subd. 5. Duties.** Specifies duties for the task force, including to develop objectives and strategies on various infrastructure topics; identify infrastructure coordination approaches; identify ways to maximize federal funding; and evaluate state agency organizational design approaches.
- **Subd. 6. Meetings.** Governs task force meetings.
- **Subd. 7. Administration.** Provides for task force administration. Directs the Legislative Coordinating Commission to provide staffing support to the task force. Establishes that task force members serve without compensation.

### **Section Description**

**Subd. 8. Report required.** Directs the task force to submit a legislative report by February 1, 2024. Specifies report contents.

**Subd. 9. Expiration.** Makes the task force expire June 30, 2024.
