### **Overview**

This bill would define the term "systemic pesticide" for purposes of state seed law and require the Minnesota Department of Agriculture (MDA) to develop a regulatory program for seed treated with a systemic pesticide.

# Summary

## Section Description

#### 1 Systemic pesticide.

Defines "systemic pesticide" for purposes of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 21 (Seeds) to mean a pesticide designed to be absorbed by plants and translocated throughout plant tissue, including certain named pesticides and other pesticides that MDA determines to be systemic.

### 2 Systemic pesticide-treated seed program.

Requires MDA to develop a systemic pesticide-treated seed regulatory program that protects human health and the environment and includes specified elements such as formal, written verification of need prior to use unless systemic pesticide-treated seed is the only commercially available option.

### 3 Systemic pesticide-treated seed alternatives account.

Establishes a new account in the agricultural fund and appropriates any money in the account to the University of Minnesota for research and outreach regarding nonchemical pest prevention alternatives to systemic pesticide-treated seed. Authorizes the University to award competitive grants.

### 4 Appropriation; systemic pesticide-treated seed program.

Appropriates an unspecified, onetime amount from the general fund to MDA to implement the program required under section 2.

### **Section Description**

5 Appropriation; systemic pesticide-treated seed alternatives account.

Appropriates an unspecified, onetime amount from the general fund for deposit in the new systemic pesticide-treated seed alternatives account.
