Overview

This bill revises the structure for the main financial accounts used by driver and vehicle services in the Department of Public Safety. It creates a new fund, merges two operating accounts (currently one each for driver-related and vehicle-related activities), and shifts the new account, along with a related information technology account, into the new fund. It makes a number of conforming changes to revise statutes accordingly, and makes some technical changes.

Article 1: Driver and Vehicle Services Fund; Combination of Accounts

This article establishes a new driver and vehicle services fund and provides for accounts within the fund.

- [Adds § 299A.704] Driver and vehicle services fund.

Establishes a driver and vehicle services fund as a new accounting fund of the state.

2 Driver and vehicle services operating account.

Merges the driver services operating account and the vehicle services operating account into a single account, the driver and vehicle services operating account. Moves the new account to be in the driver and vehicle services fund (being established in the bill).

3 Driver and vehicle services technology account.

Moves the driver and vehicle services technology account to be in the driver and vehicle services fund (being established in the bill).

Article 2: Conforming Changes

This article makes a variety of conforming and technical changes. It (1) updates various names and cross references to refer to the merged driver and vehicle services operating account as well as the driver and vehicle services fund; (2) directs the revisor of statutes to update terms elsewhere in state statutes; and (3) repeals redundant provisions on deposit of fee revenue as well as the driver services operating account (which is eliminated in conjunction with the account merger).
