Summary

Section Description

1 Prices and rates.

Adds tree trimmers and providers of restoration and mitigation services to those prohibited from charging an unconscionably excessive price or charging an insurer a rate that is charged to the public after a severe thunderstorm has occurred.

2 **Civil penalty.**

Clarifies that the penalties under this subdivision apply to sellers of essential consumer goods or services that charge an unconscionably excessive price when there has been an abnormal market disruption.

3 Enforcement.

Adds tree trimmers and providers of restoration and mitigation services to the list of the actors the attorney general can take action against to enforce and penalize behavior pursuant to this section.
