Overview

This bill requires the commissioner of human services to submit to the federal government any necessary amendments to medical assistance home and community-based waiver plans to allow providers to bill for certain services that do not require direct contact with the service recipient.

Summary

Section Description

1 Direction to commissioner; indirect billing authorization for individualized home supports.

No later than December 1, 2024, requires the commissioner of human services to submit to the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services any necessary amendments to home and community-based waiver plans to allow for providers providing individualized home supports with training, individualized home supports without training, and individualized home supports with family training to bill for services that do not require direct contact with the service recipient but are within an allowable community living service category. Lists allowable tasks that may be billed. Lists circumstances under which individualized home supports services that do not require direct contact may be billed.
