This bill appropriates money for a pediatric hospital-to-home transition pilot program.

Summary

1 Appropriation; pediatric hospital-to-home transition pilot program.

Appropriates \$1,040,000 in fiscal year 2025 from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for a single competitive grant to a home care nursing provider to develop and implement, in coordination with other specified entities, a pilot program to expedite and facilitate pediatric hospital-to-home discharges for patients receiving services under medical assistance (MA), including under certain MA disability waivers. Specifies this is a onetime appropriation and is available until June 30, 2027. Specifies allowable uses of grant money. Prohibits grant money from being used to supplement payment rates for MA covered services. Requires the commissioner to prepare a report summarizing the impact of the pilot program and submit the report to the legislative committees with jurisdiction over health and human services by December 15, 2026.
