Subject Use of Bows Near Buildings and Livestock

Summary

This bill would prohibit a person from discharging a bow within 500 feet of a building occupied by a human or livestock without the written permission of the owner, occupant, or lessee if on another person's private property or on a public road right-of-way. The bill would also prohibit a person from discharging a bow within 500 feet of stockade or corral confining livestock without permission (this provision would not apply during a hunting season when on state or local government owned land, excluding road right-of-ways).

Discharging a firearm is currently subject to these same restrictions.
