

Bill Summary H.F. 4642 As Introduced

Summary

This bill would allow an electronic licensing system (ELS) agent or the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to charge a \$1 issuing fee when selling the walleye stamp. Under current law, certain limits and restrictions apply to issuing fees, including prohibiting a fee to be charged for stamps issued simultaneously with a license.

The walleye stamp is a voluntary stamp that can be purchased for \$5. Revenues from the stamp are deposited in the walleye stamp account and may be used only for stocking state waters with walleye purchased from the private sector.
