INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF HOUSE BILLS

The following House Files were introduced:

Lislegard introduced:

H. F. No. 43, A bill for an act relating to capital investment; appropriating money for improvements to the City of Aurora Community Center; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.

The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Capital Investment.

Baker introduced:

H. F. No. 44, A bill for an act relating to health; providing exceptions to the hospital construction moratorium; amending Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 144.551, subdivision 1.

The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Health Finance and Policy.

Grossell introduced:

H. F. No. 45, A bill for an act relating to transportation; requiring the commissioner of transportation to inspect trains entering the state from Canada; appropriating money; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 219.

The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Transportation Finance and Policy.

Grossell introduced:

H. F. No. 46, A bill for an act relating to economic development; establishing a forgivable loan program for remote recreational businesses; requiring a report; appropriating money.

The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Workforce and Business Development Finance and Policy.

Igo introduced:

H. F. No. 47, A bill for an act relating to economic development; establishing an oriented strand board production incentive program; appropriating money; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 41A.

The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Agriculture Finance and Policy.

Mortensen introduced:

H. F. No. 48, A bill for an act relating to state government; prohibiting the imposition of certain taxes during a shutdown period; prohibiting the expiration of state licensing during a shutdown period; amending Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 290.0131, by adding a subdivision; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 290; proposing coding for new law as Minnesota Statutes, chapter 12C.

The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Taxes.
