1.8	kit, or a short-barreled shotgun may be sentenced to imprisonment for not more than five
1.9	<u>20</u> years or to payment of a fine of not more than $\frac{10,000}{35,000}$, or both.
1.10	(b) Except as otherwise provided herein, whoever owns, possesses, or operates a
1.11	short-barreled shotgun may be sentenced to imprisonment for not more than five years or
1.12	to payment of a fine of not more than \$10,000, or both.
