An appropriation that will allow Abijah's licensed master level mental health providers to facilitate mental health equine experiential therapy to first responders suffering from job-related trauma and post-traumatic stress disorder.



NO COST if H.F. 506 is passed

NO REPORTING — Abijah's works outside the confines of insurance reporting requirements, providing an added level of confidentiality for first responders who may fear mental health stigma.

NO DIAGNOSIS — The goal of our program is to work towards wellness, not necessarily a label or diagnosis.

NO EXPLANATIONS — The Abijah's model does not need first responders to recount the details of past traumas, only to be present and open to transformation.
