1.2 (H0845DE4), as follows:

1.3 Page 19, delete lines 5 to 20 and insert:

1.4 "(1) offering interdisciplinary courses that encourage students to think across
1.5 disciplinary boundaries and take advantage of the university-wide intellectual expertise;

1.6 (2) expanding undergraduate academic advising, including intrusive advising, and
1.7 the use of online advising tools;

1.8 (3) assisting undecided students with personalized services to help them develop a
1.9 plan for major and career selection;

1.10 (4) requiring all students to fill out, and regularly update, their four-year degree plans;

1.11 (5) facilitating student transfers to the University of Minnesota through support of
1.12 the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum and other transfer tools;

1.13 (6) developing strategies to encourage students to enroll full time and graduate
1.14 in four years; and
