1.9 including paper, glass, plastics, metals, automobile oil, batteries, ~~and~~ source-separated
1.10 compostable materials, and sole source food waste streams that are managed through
1.11 biodegradative processes. Refuse-derived fuel or other material that is destroyed by
1.12 incineration is not a recyclable material.

1.13 Sec. 97. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 115A.551, subdivision 2a, is amended to read:

1.14 Subd. 2a. **County recycling goals.** (a) By December 31, 2030, each county will
1.15 have as a goal to recycle the following amounts:

1.16 (1) for a county outside of the metropolitan area, 35 percent by weight of total
1.17 solid waste generation; and

1.18 (2) for a metropolitan county, 75 percent by weight of total solid waste generation.

1.19 (b) Each county will develop and implement or require political subdivisions within
1.20 the county to develop and implement programs, practices, or methods designed to meet its
1.21 recycling goal. Nothing in this section or in any other law may be construed to prohibit a
1.22 county from establishing a higher recycling goal.

1.23 (c) Any quantified recyclable materials that meet the definition in subdivision 1,
1.24 paragraph (a), or section 115A.03, subdivision 25a, are eligible to be counted toward a
1.25 county's recycling goal under this subdivision."
