

1.1 ..... moves to amend H.F. No. 890, the delete everything amendment (A17-0268),  
1.2 as follows:

1.3 Page 48, after line 9, insert:

1.4 "The state plan must be consistent and aligned, to the extent practicable, with the  
1.5 performance accountability measures required under section 120B.11, subdivision 1a, to  
1.6 create a single accountability system for all public schools.

1.7 The state plan must include indicators of school quality or student success based on the  
1.8 following:

1.9 (1) for elementary and secondary schools:

1.10 (i) reading and math growth for students performing in the bottom quartile, as measured  
1.11 on the state accountability assessments, and using growth to proficiency standards;

1.12 (ii) third grade reading proficiency as measured on the state accountability assessments;

1.13 (iii) eighth grade mathematics proficiency as measured on state accountability  
1.14 assessments; and

1.15 (iv) science proficiency as measured on state accountability assessments.

1.16 (2) career and college readiness of high school students as measured by:

1.17 (i) the high school accountability assessments;

1.18 (ii) student success or attainment on advanced placement or international baccalaureate  
1.19 examinations;

1.20 (iii) college-level examination program examinations;

1.21 (iv) credits under section 124D.09; and

1.22 (v) industry-recognized certifications."
