## **Overview**

This bill makes technical and policy changes related to limited supervised practice of former alcohol and drug counseling students, substance use disorder (SUD) treatment program HIV training, withdrawal management program licensing, and SUD treatment provider client record documentation requirements.

# **Summary**

#### Section Description

## 1 Former students.

Amends § 148F.11 by adding subd. 2a. Allows a former student to practice alcohol and drug counseling at the site where the student completed their internship for 90 days from the former student's degree conferral date or date of last credit received; requires former student practice to be supervised; specifies that former student practice is paid; specifies that this practice automatically expires after 90 days.

### 2 HIV training in substance use disorder treatment program.

Amends § 245A.19. Makes technical changes; removes obsolete date; requires commissioner to outline HIV minimum standards training content, rather than provide training.

### 3 General application and license requirements.

Amends § 245F.04, subd. 1. Allows supervised living facilities with a class A license to operate withdrawal management programs (current law limits this to facilities with class B licenses).

### 4 Client record documentation requirements.

Amends § 245G.06, subd. 2a. Makes technical change requiring documentation of a significant event within 24 hours of the event, rather than "on the day" of the event.
