
Death of Kadin Huntley one of 5 in the last 9 years at deadly intersection

(Danube MN-) The death of 19-year-old Kadin Huntley of Montevideo last weekend is the 5th fatal crash in the last 9 years at the intersection of Renville County Roads 1 and 4, eight miles south of Danube.. East-west traffic on 4 has a stop sign, while north-south traffic on 1 does not. Huntley died after the car he was riding in went through the stop sign Sunday and was hit by a southbound SUV. In June of 2019, 22-year-old Madison Vagle of Redwood Falls was a passenger in a vehicle that was hit by a semi at that intersection and died of her injuries. Two months later, in August of 2019, 88-year-old Anna Jansen of St. Michael and 53-year-old David Swanson of Lincoln Nebraska died in a crash there. And in September 2013, 47-year-old Curtis Schmidt of Danube was killed

(Olivia MN-) Renville County officials say they have made efforts to improve safety at a deadly intersection south of Danube. Since 2013 five people have died as a result of crashes at the intersection of County Roads 1 and 4. The most recent took the life of 19-year-old Kadin Huntley of Montevideo who passed away August 29th after a crash the day before. East-west traffic on 4 is supposed to stop, and Renville County Public Works Director and Highway Engineer Jeff Marlow says

while no official traffic or crash study has been done at that intersection, they have put rumble strips in
the pavement ahead of the stop signs and they have put up dual "stop ahead" signs. They have also put
LED flashing stop signs up, under which are yellow signs stating "cross traffic does not stop."
Marlowe says they have seen people running stop signs on County Road 4 not only at County Road 1
but also at County Road 5 and Highways 4 and 71. He said the Highway 71 detour added a lot of traffic
to both County Roads 1 and 4, and that detour was lifted just before the Labor Day holiday weekend.

Madison Vagle, 22, of Redwood Falls, died Sunday, according to information that the Hennepin County Medical Examiner's office reported to the Renville County Sheriff's Office.

The cause of death is pending an autopsy by the Hennepin County Medical Examiner's Officer.

Vagle had been airlifted from the accident scene to North Memorial Hospital in Robbinsdale by North Air Care with serious injuries.

The accident occurred at 3:24 p.m. Friday at the intersection of County Road 1 and County Road 4 about eight miles south of Danube.

A 2004 International tractor truck and trailer, driven by Mark Wagner, 62, of Bird Island, and a 1996 Subaru Legacy, driven by Haley Winslow, 18, of Franklin, collided. Vagle was a passenger in the Legacy.

The International truck and trailer was traveling east on County Road 4 and failed to yield after stopping at the stop sign at the intersection of County Road 4 and County Road 1, according to

information from the Renville County Sheriff's Office. The Legacy was traveling north on County Road 1.

Wagner was transported to RC Hospital in Olivia by the Olivia Ambulance Service with non-life-threatening injuries. Winslow was transported to Carris Health -Redwood Falls by Renville Ambulance and later flown to North Memorial Hospital by North Air Care.

The Sheriff's Office is investigating the accident.

Crash kills Gustavus women's hockey player from Little Canada, injures 3 teammates and other driver

Jori Lynn Jones was remembered Monday for her passion for hockey and positive attitude, traits her coaches say made her excel on and off the ice as a player and teammate in Roseville and then at Gustavus Adolphus College in St. Peter, Minn.

Jones, a freshman goaltender on last season's Gustavus team that won the college's <u>first NCAA Division III national championship</u> in March, was killed and three of her teammates were injured in a two-vehicle crash Sunday afternoon in west-central Minnesota. Jones, who was a passenger, died at Montevideo Hospital. She was 19.

Jones, of Little Canada, had played youth and high school hockey in Roseville, where her family is a "staple in the hockey community," Craig Rosenthal, head coach of the Roseville/Mahtomedi girls hockey team, said Monday.

"I've coached high school hockey for 17 years, and Jori had one of the best personalities

19, of Lakeville and Lily Kay Mortenson, 19, of Champlin were taken to the hospital with injuries not considered life-threatening, according to the State Patrol.

The women were returning home from South Dakota after a weekend trip with other teammates "that they had organized together," said Mike Carroll, head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus women's hockey team.

"Our chemistry on our team, from the youngest to the oldest player, is exceptionally close," he said.

Crash west of Willmar

The crash happened about 12:40 p.m. Sunday in Grace Township, about 25 miles west of Willmar.

According to a State Patrol report, Gasparini was driving a Chevrolet Equinox east on Highway 40, while the other driver, Brandi Kay Rasmussen, 28, of Benson, Minn., was in a Dodge Caravan headed south on Highway 29.

The vehicles collided when one of the drivers failed to stop at a stop sign, said State Patrol Sgt. Troy Christianson on Monday, without specifying which one.

"We're not releasing that until after we get our witness statements," he said.

The intersection is a four-way stop, with the speed limit in the area 60 mph, he said.

Alcohol was not a factor in the crash, according to the State Patrol's report, which added that all five women were wearing seatbelts.

'Kind, vibrant girl'

As news of the crash spread on social media, Minnesota Hockey and others offered their sympathies and support to the Jones family and Roseville and Gustavus hockey communities.

"We also ask everyone to keep those who were injured in their thoughts," read a statement by Minnesota Hockey, the governing body for youth and amateur hockey in the state.

Tracy Mortenson, Lily's mother, wrote in a Facebook post Monday morning that "Lily is banged up pretty good. Considering the gravity of the accident we are very lucky that she is ok."

Mortenson said her "heart is torn to pieces for Jori's family, friends, and all that loved her. She was a beautiful, kind, and vibrant girl. Please keep the girls in your thoughts and prayers, most importantly Jori Jones' family as they need the most strength to navigate through this indescribable tragedy."

In a Twitter post, Roseville Area Youth Hockey <u>wrote</u>, "We are gutted and at loss for words. Please keep the Jones family in your prayers. She was truly a remarkable human. We love you Jori."


Jones' father, Jon Jones, is a volunteer firefighter in Little Canada and a coach for the youth association, which in May was dealt a loss when coach Michael Brasel was shot and killed outside his home in St. Paul's St. Anthony Park neighborhood.

Over the years, Jones coached Jori's teams and those of her younger siblings — Kylie and Beckam, said Gretchen Hopeman, president of the hockey association, in a <u>Facebook post</u>. Kylie was recently named a senior captain of the high school team, while Beckam will be in his second year as a Bantam player.

A GoFundMe page for the Jones family has raised more than \$105,000 as of Thursday night.

"Let's join together as a community to envelop them with love and support during this challenging period," Hopeman wrote. "This summer has brought us all a great deal of hardship, but we are a remarkable and unique community, bound together by our love for hockey."

Carroll said he reached out to Jones' father and mother, Britt Jones, on Sunday night through a text message. He said he got a reply back Monday morning "which made me feel good that they're trying to work through things as best they possibly can. The message I received was that Jori was very proud to be a Gustie."
