<sup>1</sup> For cities and towns, funds unexpended by November 15, 2020 must be sent to its home county or if located in Hennepin or Ramsey, transferred to an eligible hospital by November 20, 2020. For counties and hospitals under this section, funds unexpended by December 1, 2020 must be returned to the Commissioner of Revenue by December 10, 2020 and canceled to CRFF.

<sup>2</sup> Counties with a population of at least 500,000 received CARES Act funds directly from the US Treasury (Hennepin \$220.88 million and Ramsey \$96.03 million) and thus are not included in this distribution to local governments.
