1.6 means a student who has an immediate family member, including a parent or sibling, who:

1.7 (1) is currently a member of the armed forces serving as either a reservist or on active duty

1.8 in the United States Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, or Coast Guard; (2) is currently

1.9 serving in the Minnesota National Guard; (3) has recently retired from the armed forces; or

1.10 (4) is the dependent of a member of the armed forces who was killed in the line of duty.

## 1.11 Subd. 2. Purple Star School. (a) The commissioner of education may designate a school 1.12 as a Purple Star School if the school:

1.13 (1) has a designated staff member serving as a military liaison whose duties include:

1.14 (i) identifying military-connected students enrolled at the school;

1.15 (ii) serving as the point of contact between the school and military-connected students

- 1.16 and families;
- 1.17 (iii) determining appropriate school services available to military-connected students;
- 1.18 **and**
- 1.19 (iv) assisting in coordinating school programs relevant to military-connected students;

## 1.20 (2) maintains easily accessible information on the school website that includes resources

- 1.21 for military-connected students and families, including information regarding:
- 1.22 (i) student relocation, student enrollment, student registration, and transfer of school
- 1.23 records;

2.1	(ii) academic planning, course offerings, and advanced classes available at the school;
2.2	(iii) counseling and other support services available for military-connected students
2.3	enrolled at the school; and
2.4	(iv) the designated military liaison under clause (1);
2.5	(3) offers a transition program led by students, where appropriate, that assists
2.6	military-connected students in transitioning into the school;
2.7	(4) offers professional development opportunities for staff members on issues related
2.8	to military-connected students; and
2.9	(5) offers at least one of the following:
2.10	(i) a resolution showing support for military-connected students and families;
2.11	(ii) recognition of the Month of the Military Child or Military Family Month with relevant
2.12	events hosted by the school; or
2.13	(iii) a partnership with a local military installation that provides opportunities for active
2.14	duty military members to volunteer at the school, speak at an assembly, or host a field trip.
