COMMITTEE ON RULES AND LEGISLATIVE ADMINISTRATION 1 2 3 **Resolution on Administration of Educational Programs** 4 5 **High School Page Program** 6 BE IT RESOLVED, by the Committee on Rules and Legislative Administration that a High 7 School Page Program administered by the Sergeant-at-Arms must conform to the following 8 requirements: The maximum number of participants in the program during each year of the 9 biennial legislative session is 100. If there are no applicants for the program from a house 10 district, the Sergeant-at-Arms may, at the Sergeant's discretion, select another student. High 11 school pages serve for a period of one week and receive a stipend of \$10.00 per day. High 12 school pages may choose to stay in lodging arranged for and paid by the House. The Sergeant-13 at-Arms shall report to the House Budget and Accounting Office the names of all high school 14 pages. The House of Representatives provides limited supervision for high school pages outside 15 of normal working hours, and the Sergeant-at-Arms shall so inform the parents or guardians of 16 each high school page prior to the page's participation in the program. 17 18 **Undergraduate Internship Program** 19 BE IT RESOLVED, by the Committee on Rules and Legislative Administration that an 20 Undergraduate Internship Program administered by the Sergeant-at-Arms must conform to the 21 following requirements: 22 • The maximum number of participants in the program during each year of the biennial 23 legislative session is 40. 24 • Undergraduate Interns shall receive a stipend of \$50.00 for completing 6 hours of 25 participation each week only during the 2023 legislative session. 26 • Undergraduate Interns shall receive a stipend of \$75.00 for completing 6 hours of 27 participation each week only during the 2024 legislative session. 28
