1.15 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 85.055, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.16 Subdivision 1. **Fees.** The fee for state park permits for:

1.17 (1) an annual use of state parks is ~~\$25~~ \$35;

1.18 (2) a second or subsequent vehicle state park permit is ~~\$18~~ \$26;

1.19 (3) a state park permit valid for one day is ~~\$5~~ \$7;

1.20 (4) a daily vehicle state park permit for groups is ~~\$3~~ \$5;

1.21 (5) an annual permit for motorcycles is ~~\$20~~ \$30;

1.22 (6) an employee's state park permit is without charge; and

2.1 (7) a state park permit for persons with disabilities under section 85.053, subdivision 7,  
2.2 paragraph (a), clauses (1) to (3), is \$12.

2.3 The fees specified in this subdivision include any sales tax required by state law.

2.4 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 168.1295, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

2.5 Subdivision 1. **General requirements and procedures.** (a) The commissioner shall  
2.6 issue state parks and trails plates to an applicant who:

2.7 (1) is a registered owner of a passenger automobile, recreational vehicle, one ton pickup  
2.8 truck, or motorcycle;

2.9 (2) pays a fee of \$10 to cover the costs of handling and manufacturing the plates;

2.10 (3) pays the registration tax required under section 168.013;

2.11 (4) pays the fees required under this chapter;

2.12 (5) contributes a minimum of ~~\$50~~ \$60 annually to the state parks and trails donation  
2.13 account established in section 85.056; and

2.14 (6) complies with this chapter and rules governing registration of motor vehicles and  
2.15 licensing of drivers.

2.16 (b) The state parks and trails plate application must indicate that the contribution specified  
2.17 under paragraph (a), clause (5), is a minimum contribution to receive the plate and that the  
2.18 applicant may make an additional contribution to the account.

2.19 (c) State parks and trails plates may be personalized according to section 168.12,  
2.20 subdivision 2a."
