What:

- The Greater Twin Cities Regional Public Safety Training Facility would serve law enforcement, fire, and public works.
- Senate File 823 - Chief author: Senator Jerry Newton
- House File 926 - Chief author: Representative Erin Koegel

Why:

- Limited local training options currently exist.
- North metro communities suffer from lack of training space.
- The need for this type of facility in the north metro was identified by the Department of Public Safety in 2009.
- The project has support from 21 public safety agencies in Anoka County.
- The facility will serve the entire region for decades.
- The nearest multi-discipline training area is the South Metro Public Safety Training Center in Edina.

The need:

- Pre-design/design funding is needed from the State of Minnesota to get this regional impact project started.
