Overview

This bill creates a new section titled the "Gender-Affirming Rights Act" and provides that an individual has a right to make decisions about their gender and related gender-affirming health care decisions and that a local unit of government may not restrict those rights ensured by the section or Minnesota Constitution.

Summary

Section Description

1 Gender-affirming rights act.

Creates a new section of law in Chapter 144, to provide that every individual has a fundamental right to make autonomous decisions about an individual's gender and use of gender-affirming care and provides that a local unit of government cannot regulate the right to make autonomous decision's about a person's gender or an individual's decisions related to gender-affirming health care.
