Sec. 2. TRANSFER TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN, YOUTH, AND

FAMILIES.

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The responsibilities and authorities under Minnesota Statutes, section 256E.40, shall transfer to the Department of Children, Youth, and Families once it is operational. The revisor of statutes shall renumber Minnesota Statutes, section 256E.40, with other community social services responsibilities if legislation is enacted during the 2024 legislative session recodifying the statutes governing community social services.

Sec. 3. <u>APPROPRIATION</u>; <u>PREVENTING FOSTER CARE PLACEMENT KINSHIP</u>

GRANT PROGRAM.

\$2,200,000 in fiscal year 2025 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of children, youth, and families for the preventing foster care placement kinship grant program under Minnesota Statutes, section 256E.40. Any federal matching funds received under this section must be used for the preventing foster care placement kinship grant program. The base for this appropriation is \$3,600,000 in fiscal year 2026 and \$3,600,000 in fiscal year 2027.

Sec. 4. APPROPRIATION; SUPPORT FOR RELATIVE CAREGIVERS.

\$3,900,000 in fiscal year 2025 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of children, youth, and families for grants to eligible public and private agencies to deliver individualized support services to current and prospective relative caregivers. For purposes of this section, "relative" has the meaning given in Minnesota Statutes, section 256N.02, subdivision 18. Grantees shall support relative caregivers and prospective relative caregivers with foster care licensing and ongoing services specific to meet the unique needs of the relative children and their current or prospective relative caregivers. The commissioner shall prioritize grant awards to public and private licensing agencies that can demonstrate expertise in supporting relative caregivers."
