

1.1 moves to amend H.F. No. 2116 as follows:

1.2 Page 2, after line 17, insert:

1.3 "Sec. 3. Minnesota Statutes 2010, section 144.5509, is amended to read:

1.4 **144.5509 RADIATION THERAPY FACILITY CONSTRUCTION.**

1.5 (a) A radiation therapy facility may be constructed only by an entity owned,
1.6 operated, or controlled by a hospital licensed according to sections 144.50 to 144.56 either
1.7 alone or in cooperation with another entity.

1.8 (b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a), there shall be a moratorium on the construction
1.9 of any radiation therapy facility located in the following counties: Hennepin, Ramsey,
1.10 Dakota, Washington, Anoka, Carver, Scott, St. Louis, Sherburne, Benton, Stearns,
1.11 Chisago, Isanti, and Wright. This paragraph does not apply to the relocation or
1.12 reconstruction of an existing facility owned by a hospital if the relocation or reconstruction
1.13 is within one mile of the existing facility. This paragraph does not apply to a radiation
1.14 therapy facility that is being built attached to a community hospital in Wright County and
1.15 meets the following conditions prior to August 1, 2007: the capital expenditure report
1.16 required under Minnesota Statutes, section 62J.17, has been filed with the commissioner
1.17 of health; a timely construction schedule is developed, stipulating dates for beginning,
1.18 achieving various stages, and completing construction; and all zoning and building permits
1.19 applied for. This paragraph expires August 1, ~~2014~~ 2017.

1.20 (c) Paragraph (b) does not apply to any construction necessary to relocate a radiation
1.21 therapy machine from a community hospital-owned radiation therapy facility in the city of
1.22 Maplewood to a community hospital campus in the city of Woodbury within the same
1.23 health system."

1.24 Renumber the sections in sequence

1.25 Amend the title as follows:

- 2.1 Page 1, line 4, after the semicolon, insert "extending the moratorium on radiation
- 2.2 facility construction in certain counties;"
- 2.3 Correct the title numbers accordingly
