Name	Purpose of the Dedicated Funds
AG-Indirect Costs	MS 16A.127, subd. 3(b) Indirect costs are recovered from federal grants based on a federal approved indirect cost rate and the funds are used to pay administrative expenses.
AG-Forfeiture	MS 609.5315, subd. 5 Forfeiture funds are received from the sale of forfeiture property after deducting expenses of which 20% are received by the prosecuting agency and are used for prosecutorial purposes.
False Claims Act	Laws 2009, Ch. 101, Art. 2, Sec.38, subd. 2 Funds are for litigation and related expenses under Minn. Laws, Ch. 101, Art. 2, sections 24-39 referred to as the False Claims Act.
Med Fraud-Program Income	Laws 2009, Ch. 101, Art. 2, Sec.38, subd. 1 Funds are collected through Medicaid Fraud investigations and are used for purposes approved by the federal agency.
AG-CLE Registration	MS 16A.721, subd. 2 The AGO holds various CLE training seminars with receipts collected to help offset costs related to the training seminar.
Copy Reimbursements	MS 13.03, subd. 1 Funds are received when outside entities request specific copies of data with the funds collected being used to pay for the copying costs.
AG-Partner	MS 8.15, subd. 3 Funds are received through various partner agreements for legal services provided to those agencies.
