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"Sec. <u>DUPLICATION OF ACTIVITIES OR PROGRAMS; LEGISLATIVE</u> AUDITOR REVIEW.

It is the intent of the legislature that this act, and Laws 2023, chapter 61, article 8, be construed to maximize efficiencies and cost savings in state government, and to eliminate the duplication of activities or programs across multiple agencies. No later than January 15, 2025, the legislative auditor is requested to conduct a program evaluation to determine whether Laws 2023, chapter 61, article 8, and this act, have been implemented consistent with the intent described in this section. If the legislative auditor determines that duplication of an activity or program exists across multiple agencies, the auditor must identify the duplication and the associated cost, and make recommendations on its elimination. The legislative auditor is requested to submit the final program evaluation to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over state government finance and over the operating budget of the impacted agency."
