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Primary Care



- Primary Care includes:
 - Acute problems sore throat, sprain, tooth pain
 - Chronic problems diabetes, back, schizophrenia
 - Prevention smoking, obesity, heart, teeth
 - Family Issues depression, asthma, ADHD,
 - Community issues TB, H1N1, lead

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What problems do our patients have?



- Prenatal Screen, CUHCC, 2008
 - 66% lacked social support
 - 40% housing problems
 - 50% transportation difficulties
 - 26% food insecurities
 - 10% partner violence
 - 20% serious depression
 - 20% moderate alcohol use
 - 19% moderate drug use
 - 31% smoking

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What are we doing at CUHCC?



- Case managers -- for SPMI patients
- RN Care Managers -- for OB, diabetes, kids
- Computer “alerts” for preventive services
- “Panels” of patients with chronic disease
- Classes for cultural groups to address diabetes and mental health issues
- Triage for urgent and emergency care

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What are we doing at CUHCC?



- Preventive services for our seriously mentally ill patients (1,830)
- “Bright Smiles”- Dental for kids & prenatal
 - 74 to 80% with prevention visit
- “Healthy Kids” – prevention for kids
 - 78 to 86% with Well Child Visit
