1.2 Page R51-A3, Senate language, (UEH1065-1)

1.3 Page 73, delete section 20 and insert:

1.4 "Sec. 20. **SHORT-CALL SUBSTITUTE TEACHER PILOT.**

1.5 Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 122A.18, subdivision 7a, the Professional
1.6 Educator Licensing and Standards Board may allow a person who meets the professional
1.7 requirements of Minnesota Statutes, section 122A.181, subdivision 2, paragraph (b), to be
1.8 employed as a short-call substitute teacher in any content area, not only career and technical
1.9 education. The board must obtain a criminal history background check on all first-time
1.10 applicants in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, section 122A.181, subdivision 8. A
1.11 short-call substitute teacher must comply with the code of ethics and the board may suspend
1.12 or revoke a short-call substitute teacher license if the teacher violates the code of ethics.

1.13 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective for the 2021-2022 school year only."
