Subject School Accountability

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Overview

This bill establishes a pilot program that requires participating schools to use an equity-focused framework with specific school performance measures not based on test scores, graduation rates, and world's best workforce goals.

1 Pilot program to improve educational outcomes and accountability.

Establishes a pilot program requiring participating schools to use an equity-focused framework to assess school performance.

Subd. 1. Establishment. Requires the Department of Education to establish a pilot program to redesign performance frameworks for high schools to improve educational outcomes for students of color.

Subd. 2. Performance measures. Requires a school in the pilot program to use an equity-focused framework with specific components.

Subd. 3. Reports. Requires the commissioner of education to submit reports to the legislature by July 1, 2024, and July 1, 2025, on the pilot program.

2 Appropriation; pilot program.

Appropriates money for a grant to Pillsbury United Communities to collaborate with the Department of Education to implement the pilot program.
