When a redistricting authority fails to state the reasons for the plan design or its rationale for deviation from guidelines set out by federal and state law, then the public's ability to support a plan is diminished.

I ask that the redistricting web site lists guidelines set out by federal and state law, what data is being used, and list members that are collectively the redistricting authority.
