1.8 clinical social worker via telephone, e-mail, facsimile, or other means of communication
1.9 to primary care practitioners, including pediatricians. The need for consultation and the

1.11 primary care practitioner. If the patient consents, and subject to federal limitations and
1.12 data privacy provisions, the consultation may be provided without the patient present."
