1.5 A person is guilty of a gross misdemeanor who:

1.6 (1) willfully disturbs the legislature, or either house of it, while in session;

1.7 (2) commits disorderly conduct in the presence and view of either house, tending to
1.8 interrupt its proceedings or impair the respect due to its authority; or

1.9 (3) willfully, by intimidation or otherwise, prevents a member of the legislature from
1.10 attending a session of the member's house, or of a committee of it, or from giving the
1.11 member's vote upon a question which may come before the house, or from performing any
1.12 other official act, including an arrest, or attempted arrest, of a member of the legislature by
1.13 a licensed peace officer for the sole purpose of delaying or preventing the performance
1.14 of any official act."
