1.2 (H2294DE2), as follows:

1.3 Page 6, line 12, delete everything after "shall" and insert "use past performance  
1.4 data as a major factor in selecting vendors"

1.5 Page 6, line 13, delete "health outcomes"

1.6 Page 6, line 15, after the period insert "Where possible, the assessment of past  
1.7 performance in serving persons on public programs shall be based on encounter data  
1.8 submitted to the commissioner. The commissioner shall evaluate past performance  
1.9 based on both the health outcomes of care and success rates in securing participation in  
1.10 recommended preventive and early diagnostic care. Data provided by managed care plans  
1.11 must be provided in a uniform manner as specified by the commissioner and must include  
1.12 only data on medical assistance and MinnesotaCare enrollees."
