 3.33 general fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, to provide staff services or to enter
 3.34 into contracts to assist the Sunset Advisory Commission. The general fund budget base
 3.35 for the Legislative Coordinating Commission, as established in Laws 2011, First Special

4.1 Session chapter 10, article 1, section 2, is increased by \$160,000 beginning in fiscal year
4.2 2014.

4.3 **Sec. 2. MEDICAL PRACTICE ACT; STUDY.**
