1.2 Page 3, after line 28, insert:

1.3 "Sec. 6. Minnesota Statutes 2011 Supplement, section 168.123, subdivision 1, is
1.4 amended to read:

1.5 Subdivision 1. **General requirements; fees.** (a) On payment of a fee of \$10 for
1.6 each set of two plates, or for a single plate in the case of a motorcycle plate, payment of
1.7 the registration tax required by law, and compliance with other applicable laws relating to
1.8 vehicle registration and licensing, as applicable, the commissioner shall issue:

1.9 (1) special veteran's plates to an applicant who served in the active military service
1.10 in a branch of the armed forces of the United States or of a nation or society allied with the
1.11 United States in conducting a foreign war, was discharged under honorable conditions, and
1.12 is a registered owner of a passenger automobile as defined in section 168.002, subdivision
1.13 24, recreational motor vehicle as defined in section 168.002, subdivision 27, or one-ton
1.14 pickup truck as defined in section 168.002, subdivision 21b, but which is not a commercial
1.15 motor vehicle as defined in section 169.011, subdivision 16; or

1.16 (2) a veteran's special motorcycle plate as described in subdivision 2, paragraph (a),
1.17 (f), (h), (i), or (j), or another special plate designed by the commissioner to an applicant
1.18 who is a registered owner of a motorcycle as defined in section 168.002, subdivision 19,
1.19 and meets the criteria listed in this paragraph and in subdivision 2, paragraph (a), (f), (h),
1.20 (i), or (j). Plates issued under this clause must be the same size as regular motorcycle
1.21 plates. Special motorcycle license plates issued under this clause are not subject to
1.22 section 168.1293.

1.23 (b) The additional fee of \$10 is payable for each set of veteran's plates, is payable
1.24 only when the plates are issued, and is not payable in a year in which stickers are issued
1.25 instead of plates.

1.26 (c) The veteran must have a certified copy of the veteran's discharge papers,
1.27 indicating character of discharge, at the time of application. If an applicant served in the

2.1 active military service in a branch of the armed forces of a nation or society allied with the
2.2 United States in conducting a foreign war and is unable to obtain a record of that service
2.3 and discharge status, the commissioner of veterans affairs may certify the applicant as
2.4 qualified for the veterans' plates provided under this section.

2.5 ~~(d) For license plates issued for one-ton trucks described in paragraph (a), clause~~
2.6 ~~(1), the commissioner shall collect a surcharge of \$5 on each \$10 fee collected under~~
2.7 ~~paragraph (a). The surcharge must be deposited in the vehicle services operating account~~
2.8 ~~in the special revenue fund.~~

2.9 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.

2.10 Sec. 7. **APPROPRIATION; SOFT BODY ARMOR.**

2.11 \$515,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of public safety
2.12 in fiscal year 2012 for soft body armor reimbursements under Minnesota Statutes, section
2.13 299A.38. This is a onetime appropriation. Any unexpended funds may be carried over
2.14 into fiscal year 2013.

2.15 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.

2.16 Sec. 8. **APPROPRIATION; DISASTER DEFICIENCY.**

2.17 \$235,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of public safety
2.18 in fiscal year 2012. This appropriation is to provide a match for Federal Emergency
2.19 Management Agency (FEMA) disaster assistance to state agencies and political
2.20 subdivisions under Minnesota Statutes, section 12.221, in the area designated under
2.21 Presidential Declaration of Major Disaster, FEMA-DR-1900-MN, whether included in
2.22 the original declaration or added later by federal government action. This is a onetime
2.23 appropriation. This appropriation is available until expended.

2.24 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment."
