Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 120B.021, the commissioner of education must suspend until June 1, 2023 any implementation of revised academic standards not already implemented as of January 1, 2021 under Minnesota Statutes, section 120B.021. This suspension does not prevent the commissioner from continuing with current rulemaking activities or developing future statewide assessments. EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment."

(a) Notwithstanding subdivision 2, a pupil in kindergarten through grade 3 may only be dismissed in circumstances where the child poses a safety threat to the child or others. (b) For the purposes of this subdivision, a child poses a safety threat to the child or others when the child possesses a dangerous weapon, as defined in section 609.02, subdivision 6, or the child's actions are likely to inflict substantial bodily harm or great bodily harm on another person at school. "Substantial bodily harm" means bodily injury which involves a temporary but substantial disfigurement, or which causes a temporary but substantial loss or impairment of the function of any bodily member or organ, or which causes a fracture of any bodily member. "Great bodily harm" means bodily injury which creates a high probability of death, or which causes serious permanent disfigurement, or which causes a protracted loss or impairment of the function of any bodily member or organ or other serious bodily harm.
