| 1 | <p>Crisis management policy.</p> <p>Requires model crisis management policy to include cardiac emergency response plans. Requires districts and charter schools' crisis management policy to include a cardiac emergency response drill.</p> |
| 2 | <p>School safety drills.</p> <p>Requires private schools and other education institutions to have at least one cardiac emergency response drill.</p> |
| 3 | <p>Cardiac emergency response plan.</p> <p>Subd. 1. Cardiac emergency response plan. Defines a cardiac emergency response plan, and requires a plan to integrate evidence-based core elements. Requires a district or charter school to develop a cardiac emergency response plan beginning in the 2024-2025 school year. Provides requirements for contents of plan and process for distributing and reviewing plan.</p> <p>Subd. 2. Training requirements. Requires districts and charter schools to provide members of a cardiac emergency response team with training.</p> |
| 4 | <p>Cardiac emergency response plan. [Duties, policies, criteria, rules of board]</p> <p>Requires the High School League to adopt a cardiac emergency response plan, and ensure a cardiac emergency response team is present at interscholastic athletic activities.</p> |
